



# TIER 5 YOUTH MOBILITY VISA



## What is it?

- This visa, allows you to work or study, in the UK, for up to 2 years.
- You can apply up to 6 months before you plan to arrive in the UK and can leave and come back throughout your two-year stay.
- You have an option to be self-employed and establish your own business – in rented offices – however you cannot not have a workforce to complement your business.
- You are unable to bring family members as your dependents on this visa (they must qualify for their own visa, if applicable), and you must leave the UK at the end of the two years.

## Who can apply?

- You must be aged 18–30 and have the equivalent of £ 1,890 in savings before applying.
- You must be a resident of one of the following countries:
  - Australia
  - Canada
  - Japan
  - Monaco
  - New Zealand
  - Hong Kong
  - Republic of Korea
  - Taiwan
  - Be a British overseas citizen
  - Be a British Overseas Territories citizen
  - Be a British national (overseas)
- You can't apply if you have children that are financially dependent on you, or if you have been to the UK before under the 'working holidaymaker' scheme.

## How much is it?
